Subject: Workshop and Required SPEAK Test for GTAs

All graduate students scheduled to hold GTA appointments, including GAANN Scholars, must successfully complete a workshop before teaching in order to meet the standards established by the campus and Board of Curators in compliance with Missouri Revised Statutes, Chapter 170.012.

A graduate student who was required to provide English proficiency at the time of application may not teach in their first semester at S&T, per Section 170.012.1 of the Missouri Revised Statutes. If they have studied at Missouri S&T for fewer than four semesters, they must satisfy a minimum score on the speaking portion of the TOEFL iBT or IELTS in order to be considered for a GTA appointment. Students not meeting the aforementioned requirement may opt to re-take the TOEFL or IELTS or to be assessed by a SPEAK test prior to attending the GTA Workshop.

There will be three workshops per year: January, May, August. Names must be submitted no later than one week prior to the date of the workshop. SPEAK tests will be offered 2 - 3 weeks prior to the deadline for the department to submit names for the GTA workshop.

Please see the following process:

- The Department Chair or designee must submit the names of all prospective GTAs by completing the [google form](#).
- The Office of Graduate Studies will contact the student and provide the link to the online application.
- If required, the student and department will be notified of the results of the English Proficiency evaluation prior to the GTA workshop.
- After the workshop is completed, the department and student will receive the certificate of completion.
